Read the installation instructions and fully understand them before installing this suspension on your motorcycle. Use the factory authorized service manual as a reference during the installation.

STEP 1 (Remove the Factory Cartridges)

- 1. Remove the factory front forks. Refer to the Harley-Davidson® service manual for safe and proper removal.
- 2. Loosen the lower leg bolt with a 12mm Allen wrench. Do not remove.
- 3. Remove the fork tube cap. **Caution, this is spring-loaded and will pop.** This should be performed over a bucket to collect the oil and contents.
- 4. Remove the lower leg bolt and remove the contents of the fork to be recycled.
- 5. Remove factory fork seal ring.
- 6. Separate fork tube from leg.
- 7. Remove oil lock piece in lower leg.
- 8. Remove fork seal.
- 9. Leave factory seal washer in place.

Read the installation instructions and fully understand them before installing this suspension on your motorcycle. Use the factory authorized service manual as a reference during the installation.

STEP 2 (Reassembling the Fork with Nowaskey Fork Cartridges)

- 1. Drop the supplied oil lock piece into lower fork leg with the cup side facing up.
- 2. **Recommended:** Replace fork oil seal (OEM Part# 45875-84A). The spring side faces down toward fork lower leg.
- 3. Place top out spring inside fork tube.
- 4. Slide a Nowaskey Fork Cartridge into the fork tube with the steel bottom adaptor down and red end cap up.
- 5. **Recommended:** Replace crush washer (OEM Part# 45405-75A) located on the fork lower leg bolt. The factory ring may need to be removed first.
- 6. Install the new lower leg bolt (OEM Part# 45405-75A). Start the thread of the 12mm Allen bolt. Do not fully tighten.
- 7. Reinstall fork tube into lower fork leg.
- 8. Reinstall fork seal snap ring.
- 9. Add 118 ml (4 oz.) of shock oil to each fork leg.



The oil volume is specific to the Fork Cartridge Kit. DO NOT OVER FILL.

Failing to follow the instructions can lead to loss of vehicle control and/or damage to the forks. Failure due to improper installation is not covered by the Nowaskey Fork Cartridge warranty.

- 10. Hold the fork lower leg and fork tube in the vertical orientation. Slowly screw the Nowaskey Fork Cartridge into the fork tube with a 32mm box end wrench. Apply a thin film of oil and use special caution to prevent damage to the O-ring. Verify that fork cartridge is completely tight.
- 11. Finish tightening the lower fork leg with a 12mm Allen to the correct torque found in the Harley-Davidson® service manual.
- 12. Reinstall the newly rebuilt forks, fender, wheel, and any other previously removed components, refer to the Harley-Davidson® service manual for this step.
- 13. Make sure everything is tight and re-assembled correctly.
